All third grade students will be participating in the *Indiana Reading Evaluation and Determination (IREAD-3) Assessment*. The IREAD-3 was developed in response to Public Law 109 which requires the evaluation of reading skills for all students in third grade. The intent of this law is to ensure every student has the opportunity for future success through literacy.

How does this test affect third graders?

- Students that are at-risk of not passing IREAD-3 will be invited to participate in after school tutoring.
- Students that do not pass IREAD-3 this Spring will be invited to attend a special summer school in July.
- Students must pass IREAD-3 in order to receive instruction in reading at the 4th grade level.
