**Frequently Asked Questions**

**1. When is Freshman Orientation?**

Friday, July 25, 2019 from 9am – 11 am in the Pike Freshman Center starting in the Pike Performing Arts Center.

**2. Do I need to RSVP?**

No, you do not need to RSVP to attend orientation. It is highly recommended for all incoming freshman and parents to participate.

**3. Is there a parent’s meeting?**

Yes, we will have the welcome for all parents and their student(s) starting promptly at 9am in the Pike Performing Arts Center.

**4. Will my student receive their YCC issued laptop during orientation?**

Yes, those students who are in the YCC program can stop in the PFC cafeteria from 10am – 12pm the day of the event to pick up their child’s YCC issued laptop.

**5. What information will my child be able to learn at this orientation?**

Your child will learn a lot of important information! They will find out the teacher name and location of their homeroom. This is where they go on the first day of school to get their schedule.

**6. Will there be time to tour the school?**

Yes, you may explore the Freshman Center at your leisure and we will have teachers and student ambassadors around the school to answer your questions.

**7. Will my child get his/her schedule that day?**

No, schedules will be handed out on the first day of school in your child’s homeroom classroom. Please be sure to locate your homeroom during the orientation.
