



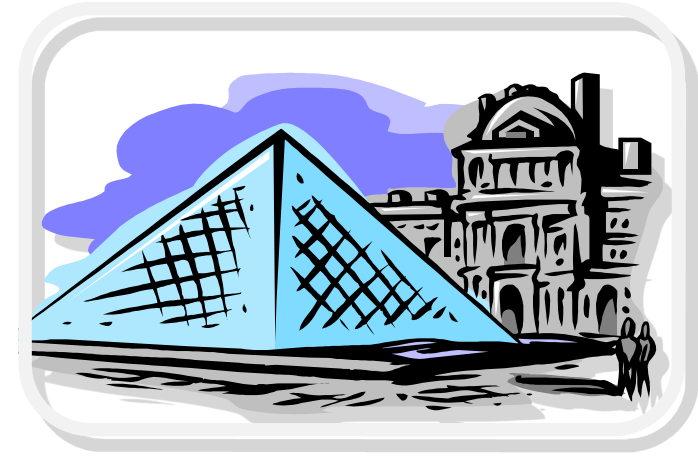
## Material
